PERRYVILLE FALL APPRECIATION DAYS PARADE INFORMATION

DATE: Saturday, October 11, 2008

ARRIVE NO LATER THAN: 9:30 A.M.

Staging Area and Drop Off Sites: The Staging Area will be Perryville Middle School (**Entrance ONLY from Coudon Boulevard**). The Church of the Good Shepherd School on Aiken Avenue will serve as a secondary drop-off site for **automobiles only**. No parking will be permitted at these sites. A map showing directions is included with this information. For questions, please call 410 642 6066.

Marching Units: Buses will be allowed to drop-off at the staging area and will be moved to the parade breakdown area on Roundhouse Drive. Those participants coming by car will follow the same procedure.

Parade Route: The parade will leave Perryville Middle School via the Aiken Avenue entrance. It will proceed to Broad Street and on to Roundhouse Drive. Antique cars/vehicles will be directed to parking at this location. Marching units and all other participants will breakdown on Roundhouse Drive. Your transportation will be parked at this location for your convenience.

Awards: Parade participants will be judged by categories and winners will be announced. Certificates will be distributed at the conclusion of the parade or mailed if you need to leave before the awards are made.

Additional Information:

1. In order to respect people with hearing problems and/or devices, etc., the committee requests that the use of sirens, shrill whistles, etc., not be activated in the parade.
2. All Parade Floats and vehicles may **NOT** be higher than 12 feet.
3. Judges Station—on Aiken Avenue. To aid the judges, please have some form of identification for your unit—a sign, banner, etc. **ANYONE WHO STOPS IN FRONT OF THE JUDGES STAND WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM RECEIVING AN AWARD.**
4. Placement in the Parade line-up will be given upon arrival at the Staging Area. If you should need to leave for another event, please state so on your application and we will attempt to place you close to the front of the line.
5. **Cancellation.** If the weather or any other circumstances prevents the parade from happening, notice will be given on WSER and WXCX radio stations or you may call 410 642 6066 or 443 309 5196. Please note that preparation for the parade and participants are booked far in advance. Sometimes we may reach a point of no return and judgement must prevail in a decision to cancel or move forward.
