#### § 5-1. RESPONSIBILITIES FOR CODE ENFORCEMENT. [Added 7-10-12 by Ord. No. 12-6]

A. The Town's Director of Planning and Zoning is designated as the "Code Official" for purposes of administering and enforcing the provisions of the Town property maintenance code set forth in Chapter 63 of this code.

B. The Town's Director of Planning and Zoning is designated as the Zoning Administrator for purposes of administering and enforcing the provisions of the Town Zoning Ordinance.

C. The Town's Director of Planning and Zoning is responsible for administering and enforcing the provisions of Chapter 30, Brush, Weeds and Grass, and Chapter 64, Property Nuisances, of this code.

D. In performing the duties and responsibilities under subsections A, B and C of this section, the Director of Planning and Zoning shall be subject to the supervision of the Town Administrator.

E. The Town's Director of Planning and Zoning may receive the assistance of the Town Administrator, Town Code Enforcement Officers and Town Sworn Law Enforcement Officers to carry out the director's duties and responsibilities under subsections A, B and C of this section.

F. In the absence of a Director of Planning and Zoning, the Town Administrator shall be responsible for the duties and responsibilities of the Director under this section.

**§ 5-2. Authority to issue infraction citations. [Added 7-10-12 by Ord. No. 12-6]**

Unless another provision of this code authorizes a specific town official or employee to issue municipal infraction citations for violations of a particular provision of the code, Town Sworn Law Enforcement Officers, Town Code Enforcement Officers, the Town Administrator and the Town Director of Planning and Zoning may issue infraction citations for violations of all provisions of this code designated as infractions.
