OF THIS SECTION, Town Commissioners and the 32 Mayor shall be elected at large by a majority vote of all registered voters of the Town of Perryville 33 casting a ballot in said election. 34 C. A QUALIFIED CANDIDATE SHALL BE DEEMED ELECTED WITHOUT THE NECESSITY 35 OF THE CONDUCT OF AN ELECTION UNDER ARTICLE V OF THIS CHARTER WHEN: 36 (1) IN THE CASE OF THE OFFICE OF MAYOR, ONLY ONE QUALIFIED CANDIDATE 37 FILES A CERTIFICATE OF NOMINATION UNDER § C5-8, AND THAT CANDIDATE IS THE 38 ELECTED INCUMBENT MAYOR; AND 39 (2) IN THE CASE OF THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER THE NUMBER OF QUALIFIED 40 CANDIDATES WHO FILE CERTIFICATES OF NOMINATION UNDER § C5-8 EQUALS OR IS 41 LESS THAN THE NUMBER OF COMMISSIONERS TO BE ELECTED TO OFFICE AT THE 42 ELECTION, AND ALL CANDIDATES ARE ELECTED INCUMBENT COMMISSIONERS. 43 SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS 44 OF THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE, that new Section C5-10 be and it hereby added to the Charter 45 of the Town of Perryville (as published in the Perryville Town Code), Article V, Registration, 46 Nominations and Elections, to follow immediately after Section 5-9 of said Article, to read as follows: 47 ARTICLE V 48 Registration, Nominations and Elections 49 § C5-10. ELECTION NOT TO BE CONDUCTED. 50 A. THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS SHALL NOT CONDUCT AN ELECTION 51 UNDER THIS ARTICLE FOR MAYOR OR COMMISSIONERS UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES 52 53 DESCRIBED IN § 3-1.C. OF THIS CHARTER. B. WHEN THERE ARE AN INSUFFICIENT NUMBER OF QUALIFIED CANDIDATES FOR 54 THE OFFICE OF MAYOR OR COMMISSIONER TO NECESSITATE THE CONDUCT OF AN 55 ELECTION FOR THAT OFFICE, ON THE DAY OF THE TOWN ELECTION THE BOARD OF 56 SUPERVISORS OF ELECTION SHALL DECLARE AND CERTIFY THE QUALIFIED 57 CANDIDATE OR CANDIDATES TO BE ELECTED TO THE OFFICE OR OFFICES FOR WHICH 58 THEY FILED CERTIFICATES OF NOMINATION. 59 60 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND SECTION 3: 61 COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE that the date of adoption of this 62 , 2023, and the amendment to the Charter of the Town of 63 Resolution is _____, 2023, unless a proper Perryville, hereby enacted shall become effective on _ 64 petition for referendum hereon shall be filed as permitted by law, provided a complete and exact copy 65 of this Resolution shall be continuously posted on the bulletin board in the Town Hall until 66 __, 2023, and provided further that a copy of the title of this Resolution shall 67 be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Perryville, or in any other newspaper 68 of such general circulation, once in each of the weeks beginning 69 __, 2023, and ____ _____, 2023. 70 , 2023, _____
