BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments Chapter 77, Vehicles and Traffic Article IV, Speed Monitoring Systems Section 77-12 Code of the Town of Perryville

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF

THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE, that new Section 77-12 be and it is hereby added to the Code

of the Town of Perryville, Chapter 77, Vehicles and Traffic, to be under the new Article IV, Speed

Monitoring Systems, to follow immediately after Section 77-11 of Article III, and to read as

 follows:

157	Transportation Article Section 21-809(b)(1)(vii) and for at least the first 15 calendar days after							
158	the signage is installed.

160	SECTION 3: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that before activating a speed							
161	monitoring system in the School Zones established by Section 1 of this Ordinance, the Town							
162	shall publish notice of the location of the speed monitoring system on its website and in a							
163	newspaper of general circulation in the Town.

165	SECTION 4: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall become							
166	effective twenty (20) calendar days after its passage by the Council.
