26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34	EXPLANATORY STATEMENT: Pursuant to §2-105 of the Criminal Procedure Article Annotated Code of Maryland, the Town of Perryville (hereinafter the "Town") may enter in mutual aid agreements for the reciprocal provision of law enforcement services by and to late enforcement agencies. §2-105 also authorizes the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town Perryville to determine the circumstances under which the police officers and other officer agents, and employees of the Town, together with all necessary equipment, may lawfully go be sent beyond the boundaries of the Town to any place within or outside the State. The Perryville Mayor and Commissioners and Chief of Police believe that it is desirable for the Town to any place within or outside the State.
