AN ORDINANCE concerning

LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

FOR the purpose of approving a certain law enforcement Memorandum of Understanding between the Town of Perryville, on behalf of the Perryville Police Department, and other law enforcement agencies providing law enforcement services in Cecil County; and generally related to providing certain authorization to Perryville Police Department law enforcement officers to exercise powers outside the corporate limits of the Town of Perryville.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT: Pursuant to §2-105 of the Criminal Procedure Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the Town of Perryville (hereinafter the “Town”) may enter into mutual aid agreements for the reciprocal provision of law enforcement services by and to law enforcement agencies. §2-105 also authorizes the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Perryville to determine the circumstances under which the police officers and other officers, agents, and employees of the Town, together with all necessary equipment, may lawfully go or be sent beyond the boundaries of the Town to any place within or outside the State. The Perryville Mayor and Commissioners and Chief of Police believe that it is desirable for the Town to have a mutual aid agreement with other law enforcement agencies providing law enforcement services in Cecil County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE that the "Memorandum of Understanding between the Maryland Transportation Authority, on behalf of the Maryland Transportation Authority Police, and the Cecil County Sheriff's Office, and the Town of Elkton, on behalf of the Elkton Police Department, and the Town of Perryville, on behalf of the Perryville Police Department, and the Town of Port Deposit, on behalf of the Port Deposit Police Department", a copy of which is attached to this Ordinance is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Chief of Police are authorized to sign the Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the Town of Perryville and the Perryville Police Department.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following approval by the Mayor and Commissioners.


