RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS TO USE CERTAIN ARPA FUNDS FOR UPGRADES TO THE TOWN'S WATER TREATMENT PLANT

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT: In July 2021, the Town of Perryville received from the State of Maryland the sum of \$2,176,930.85 under the federal government's American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARPA"). The Town anticipates receiving a similar amount of ARPA funds in July 2022. The Mayor and Commissioners have considered possible uses for the ARPA funds and have determined that the public interest would be served by using such funds as a significant funding source, along with other possible federal, State or County grants, for major upgrades to the Town's Water Treatment Plant. As currently contemplated, these upgrades would consist of a project known as Two Train Expansion and Cyclic Aeration. The cost of this project is currently estimated to be more than \$4,300,000. This project is necessary to allow the Water Treatment Plant to efficiently meet the Town's water supply requirements for future growth in the Town. The Mayor and Commissioners desire to express their intent to use some or all the ARPA funds for the Two Train Expansion and Cyclic Aeration project.

Now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE that the Mayor and Commissioners hereby express their intent to use the ARPA funds as a funding source for the Two Train Expansion and Cyclic Aeration project to the extent that funds for the project are not available from other federal, State or County grants; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, to the extent the ARPA funds are not needed for the Two Train Expansion and Cyclic Aeration project, the Town may use the ARPA funds for such other purpose or purposes as the Mayor and Commissioners may determine; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
