## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-15**

## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CECIL COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:** The Town of Perryville is extremely vulnerable to natural hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety. Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires State and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities. The Town of Perryville acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds. The Cecil County 2022 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Cecil County Department of Emergency Services in cooperation with other County departments, and officials and citizens of the Town of Perryville. A public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Cecil County 2022 Hazard Mitigation Plan. The Cecil County 2022 Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments, including the Town of Perryville. Therefore, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Perryville deem it in the interests of the Town and its residents to adopt the Cecil County 2022 Hazard Mitigation Plan as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan for the Town of Perryville.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE that the Cecil County 2022 Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Town of Perryville to the extent that the Plan is applicable to and within the Town of Perryville; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the respective officials and agencies of the Town of Perryville identified in the implementation strategy of the Cecil County 2022 Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby authorized and directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them, subject to appropriations for such purposes in the Town's budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
