RESOLUTION NO. 2024-03

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND DIRECTING A MODIFICATION TO THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE'S VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINAL LOCAL COMMUNITY IMPACT PROGRAM EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR REVITALIZATION.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT: The Town of Perryville has established a Video Lottery Terminal Local Community Impact Grant program for revitalization. Property owners submit applications that are reviewed and ranked by the Town. Ranking occurs based upon pre-established criteria. The Mayor and Commissioners have determined that a modification of the ranking criteria is desirable.

Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF PERRYVILLE that the Mayor and Commissioners approve and direct that a new ranking criterion be added to the application evaluation criteria for the Video Lottery Terminal Local Community Impact Grant program for revitalization, as follows:


“For an applicant who is a former Town elected official and who has been out of office for less than 12 months when the revitalization grant application is filed Negative 5 points.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage, but the new ranking criterion established by this Resolution shall apply to the evaluation of applications filed for grant funding in FY 25 and thereafter.
