GENERAL REFERENCES

§ 28-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

OPEN-AIR TAVERN OR PAVILION- Any bar, tavern or pavilion or portion thereof used for the purpose of eating, drinking, conducting parties or other social functions that is not enclosed by insulated walls at least two (2) inches thick and a complete roof so as to form an adequate sound barrier blocking the sound from the bar, tavern or pavilion from neighboring properties.

§ 28-2. Hours of use.

Open-air taverns or pavilions shall not be in use between the hours of 10:00 p.m. in the evening and 12:00 noon, with the exception that they may be used until 11:00 p.m. Friday night and Saturday night. Any eating , drinking, socializing, record playing, tape playing, radio playing, television playing, partying or selling or serving of food or drink during such hours in an open-air tavern or pavilion shall constitute a violation of this chapter.

§ 28-3. Violations and penalties.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of an infraction and shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.) for the first offense and one hundred dollars (\$100.) for each subsequent offense.
