§ 43-1. Prohibitions.

- A. No person (as defined in § 82-8 of the Code) shall cause, suffer, allow, start or permit a fire within the limits of the Town of Perryville except as provided in this chapter. Only those fires permitted by the Cecil County Health Department, Division of Environmental Health Services, pursuant to Title 10 of the Regulations of Health and Mental Hygiene, Subtitle 18, as amended from time to time, shall be permitted within the Town of Perryville. Prior to any such burning, a permit shall be obtained from the Cecil County Health Department.
- B. It shall be a violation of this chapter to burn refuse, garbage, trash, tires, roofing material, lumber, railroad ties, piling hazardous waste or any other such residential, institutional, commercial or industrial waste or to permit or cause any fires not specifically permitted pursuant to the provisions of this chapter.

§ 43-2. Violations and penalties.

A violation of this chapter shall be a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.) or imprisonment for thirty (30) days, or both.
