GENERAL REFERENCES

§ 59-1. Permit required; application and approval procedures; fee.

- A. No person shall organize or lead any parade or procession on the sidewalk or through any street or other public place within the Town without a permit from the Board of Commissioners.
- B. Applications for permits shall state the date upon which the parade is to take place and the hour of commencement thereof; the proposed route of march; the expected length of the column of paraders; the number and type of vehicles, if any, expected to be within the column; the purpose of the parade; and such other information as the Chief of Police may require for purpose of traffic control planning.
- C. Each application shall be in writing over the signature of the applicant, and submitted to the Town Administrator. The Town Administrator shall then conduct such investigation as may be necessary to determine the feasibility of such parade from the point of view of traffic control and shall, without delay, forward the application to the Board of Commissioners with his/her recommendations.

- D. Each application shall be accompanied with a fee of five hundred dollars (\$500.) to be paid to the Town at the time of filing the application. The Commissioners may waive the application fee at their discretion.

§ 59-2. Violations and penalties.

Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject to a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.).
