§ 72-1. Standards and Specifications.

All new streets and roads within the Town of Perryville, as well as any existing private streets and roads, shall be designed and constructed in conformity with the Cecil County Road Specifications, as adopted pursuant to Chapter 242 of the Code of Cecil County and as modified or clarified by § 255-39 of the Code of Cecil County, all as amended from time to time. No street shall be dedicated to the Town or accepted by the Town unless it complies with said specifications and regulations.

§ 72-2. Naming of streets and roads.

All new streets and roads within the Town of Perryville shall be named by the Mayor and Commissioners of Perryville, after consultation with the Cecil County Planning Department or such other department of the county government that is responsible for the naming of streets and roads, to determine that said proposed name does not duplicate the name of some other street or road within the county.
